



What is Cataract?

Cataract is the cloudiness of the human lens. When we are born, we are born with a clean lens, but with time, it becomes cloudy and interferes with the light that enters the eye causing blurred vision. Sometimes, cataract causes glare and halos at night. Cataract formation is normal to the aging process; However, certain medication, diabetes and injury can contribute to cataract formation.

There is no medication or remedy to resolve cataract or prevent it from developing. The only treatment for cataract is surgery. When the cataract causes blurred vision that interferes with daily activity such as driving or reading, proceeding with surgery is the right decision.

Cataract is removed with a small incision and a clear intraocular lens is placed in the eye without using needle injection or stitch.

Before Surgery & Treatment

After a complete examination, your eyes are measure for intraocular lens. There are 3 different options:

- A.) Best Vision Plan - Using laser or Toric lens to accomplish the best possible distance or near vision.
- B.) Traditional Cataract Surgery - State of the art cataract surgery for patients who do not have astigmatism. May need glasses for far and near sighted.
- C.) MultiFocal Vision Plan - This is a great option for patients who want to be less dependent on glasses for near and far sighted.
